- What can we do to bring a change in society- finding interest, career guidance, choosing inspiration, believing in ourselves, overcoming obstacles, etc.


She ended her presentation by guiding us with various career paths like Research, Teaching, Software services, Product development and Support.

Dr. Varsha Degaonkar Ma'am concluded the event by giving a warm vote of thanks.



Introduction:

On January 30, 2021, the I2IT IEEE Student Branch has organized a panel discussion. This Panel discussion was aimed at empowering women and provided a platform for the panelists to share their experiences and inspire fellow attendees. Attendees got insights related to confidence building, the importance of mentorship, and much more.

Utkarsh Shastrakar of the I²IT IEEE student branch started the event by welcoming the president of Hope Foundation, Aruna Katara, who gave a brief introduction about Shri Pralhad P Chhabria Awards while shared about the HFRC awards that honor young women who have been working towards the betterment of society and our nation.

Then, Dr. Rajashree Jain, Secretary, IEEE India Council explained more details of the Shri Pralhad P Chhabria Awards.

Starting off the event, Shrushti Jagtap, the Chair of I²IT's IEEE Student Branch introduced various speakers in the panel, highlighting their involvement in diverse areas of development. Panelists included: -

- 1. Dr. Celia Shahnaz
- 2. Dr. Ramalatha Marimuthu
- 3. Dr. Mini Ulanat
- 4. Ms. Madhura DasGupta Sinha

All the panelists came from various organizations and represented their views on self-advocacy, social skills, confidence building, and many other interesting things.

They answered the following and other questions in the panel discussion and gave very useful insights for future generations.

1. How did you navigate power structures EARLY in your careers versus LATER in the careers when you had a more formal leadership role?

Dr. Celia Shahnaz: She tried to make some significant contribution along with implementing what all she learned from her mentor. Networking is important in all this power structure. Her networking and her relation with her students, mentors never changed. Focus more on technical competence. Keeping good relations with all.

Dr. Ramalatha Marimuthu: Navigation as a volunteer, engineer, and the student is important from her perspective. The technical aspect is the same for everyone. The only difference is you add sustainability, management without any boundaries. Project-Based Learning is a very good concept for students to learn/apply more in research and its techniques. Outcomes are the most important things of research. Struggle shapes you, your character.

Dr. Mini Ulanat: Early career is difficult, and it takes a lot of confidence level and experience to reach that level. Passion is important for whatever you choose to do.

Ms. Madhura DasGupta Sinha: Trying to build communities of women and ensure they get enough career resources to eliminate the challenges they face and excel in their careers. Model-based on psychology is used to meet these needs. Informal power structures are much more imp when you start as a fresher in an organization. Ensure to have inspiration, a role model to reach our goals.

2. How have you built confidence and/or resiliency over the course of your career through Individual actions or the need for systemic change?

Dr. Celia Shahnaz: There will be many hurdles that will try to break your confidence. Hard work is the key to the solutions for most of the challenges you face in life. Commitment is the important factor required to build your confidence. Hard work, patience, commitment, and ethics are the important things that one should follow. Be persistent with your work. You will be recognized. Make sure to express your confidence. Saying 'NO' to every 'NO'.

Dr. Ramalatha Marimuthu: Positive approach helps a person to overcome barriers. Role models are very important to support throughout your life. Believing that what you are doing is right. Not being ashamed of setbacks. Getting involved in all things.

Dr. Mini Ulanat: Maintain motivation. Self-motivation is very important for going forward in life. Celebrate your success. You'll get confidence with time.

Ms. Madhura DasGupta Sinha: Ignite confidence which is sort of hidden in young women. Being completely prepared, enjoy what you face in life.

3. What advice would you give to girl students and women young professionals? Dr. Celia Shahnaz: Focus on skill development. Try to create a project which will help to solve the problems faced around you using the emerging technology. Community research has a high impact. Never underestimate yourself and never doubt your thinking, passion, or confidence. Giving trust to others is very important. Recognize your volunteers. Remain united and support each other.

Dr. Ramalatha Marimuthu: Take responsibility. Work towards making a positive impact on society. Have a role model. Ethics will give you the highest self-esteem.

Dr. Mini Ulanat: Follow your passion. Speak up for yourself.

Ms. Madhura DasGupta Sinha: Always be financially independent. Perseverance and resilience are important to be independent in life. Grab all opportunities that come your way.

4. What is your Opinion On self-advocacy and social skills?

Dr. Celia Shahnaz: Humbleness is very important while talking. Never express the negative stories you come across daily at your workspace. Diversity, respect, and inclusion are also important along with humbleness.

Dr. Ramalatha Marimuthu: Have courage and guts to speak up. Social skills(networking)-find the right people to implement it.

Dr. Mini Ulanat: She said we should speak up in a very ethical way.

Ms. Madhura DasGupta Sinha: Don't let yourself feel that you are not good enough for something. Fight the imposter syndrome.

Further by answering some questions from participants, the panelists enlightened the students and then Shrushti Jagtap and Utkarsh Shastrakar gave a virtual memento to all the panelists and giving a warm vote of thanks, Dr. Varsha Degaonkar, I²IT IEEE Student Branch Coordinator, concluded the event.
