#### **REPORT**

The NSS units of Hope foundation's International Institute of Information Technology, Hinjawadi Pune and Rajeshri Shahu College of Engineering had organized a one week camp in the Jambavade Village situated in Maval Taluka of Pune. This camp was organized from 30<sup>th</sup> December 2018 to 5<sup>th</sup> January 2019. The camp had decided that construction of dams which was a part of social work of the camp would be held on third and fourth day of camp.

The camp had 5 teams comprising of 10 members each. Out of 5 teams, 2 teams were selected for the construction of dams. On the first day all the 2 teams after having their breakfast arrived at the given site in village and then began to work. The whole teams first cleared a valley area and then began collecting and placing stones at the given point. On average a 6 layer earthen dam was laid. In these work girls, boys and also teachers participated. The program continued for 2 days beginning from 8 AM to 1 PM. By doing this social work we were able to block the water-flow from the valleys.

This program acknowledged the students for stopping the water current by building Earthen Dams. 4 Dams were built each day summing up to total of 8 Dams.
