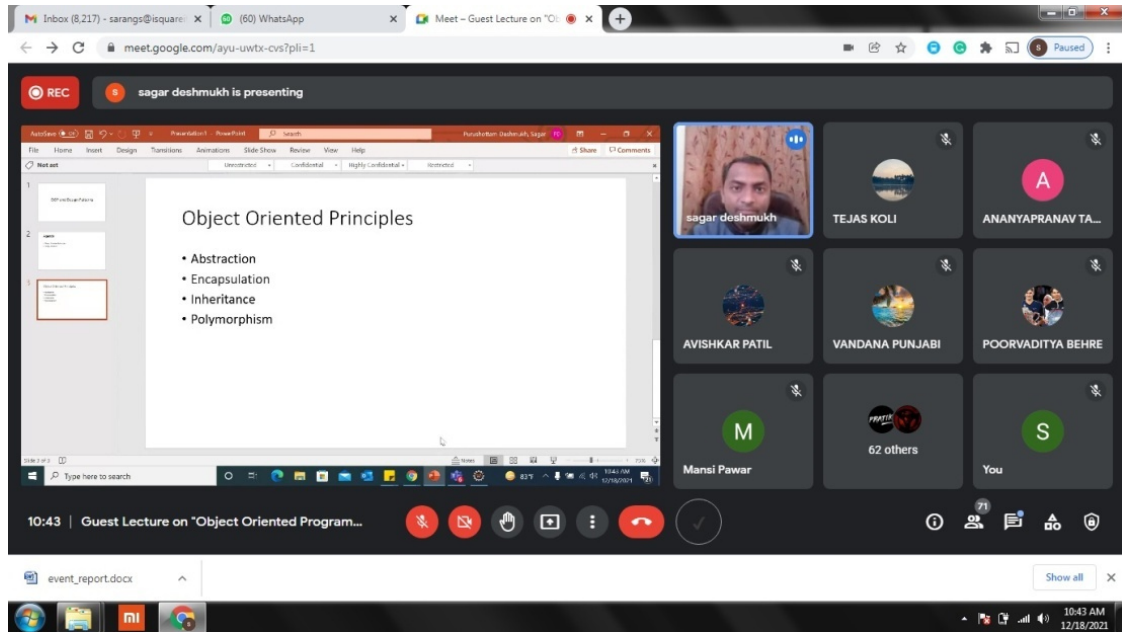


Image 1: Discussion on “Object Oriented Programming Principles” by Mr. Sagar Deshmukh

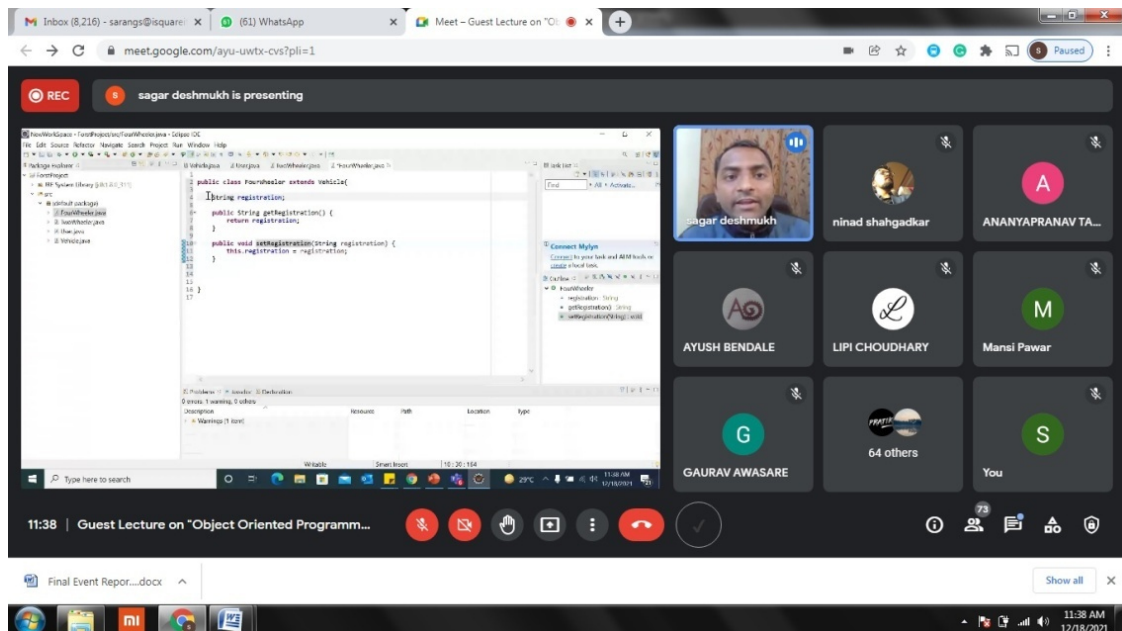


Image 2: Practical demonstration of Inheritance concept by Mr. Sagar Deshmukh
