## National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit

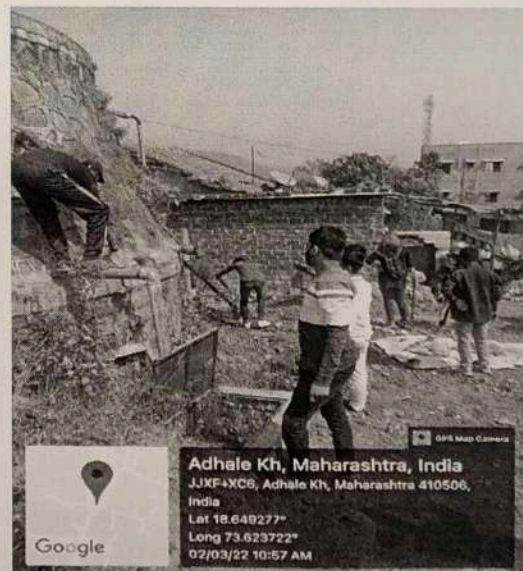

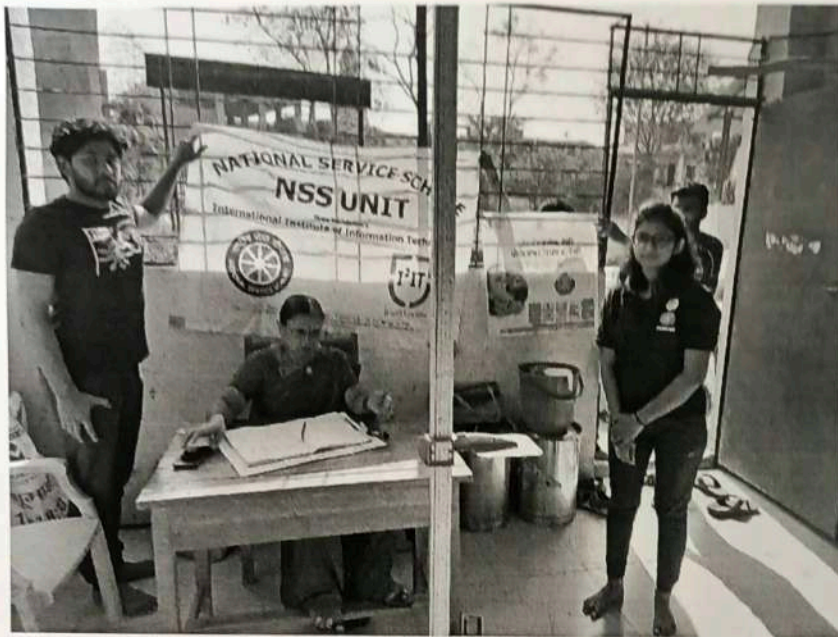


# CLEANLINESS DRIVE

# EXCAVATION OF PIT FOR TREE PLANTATION

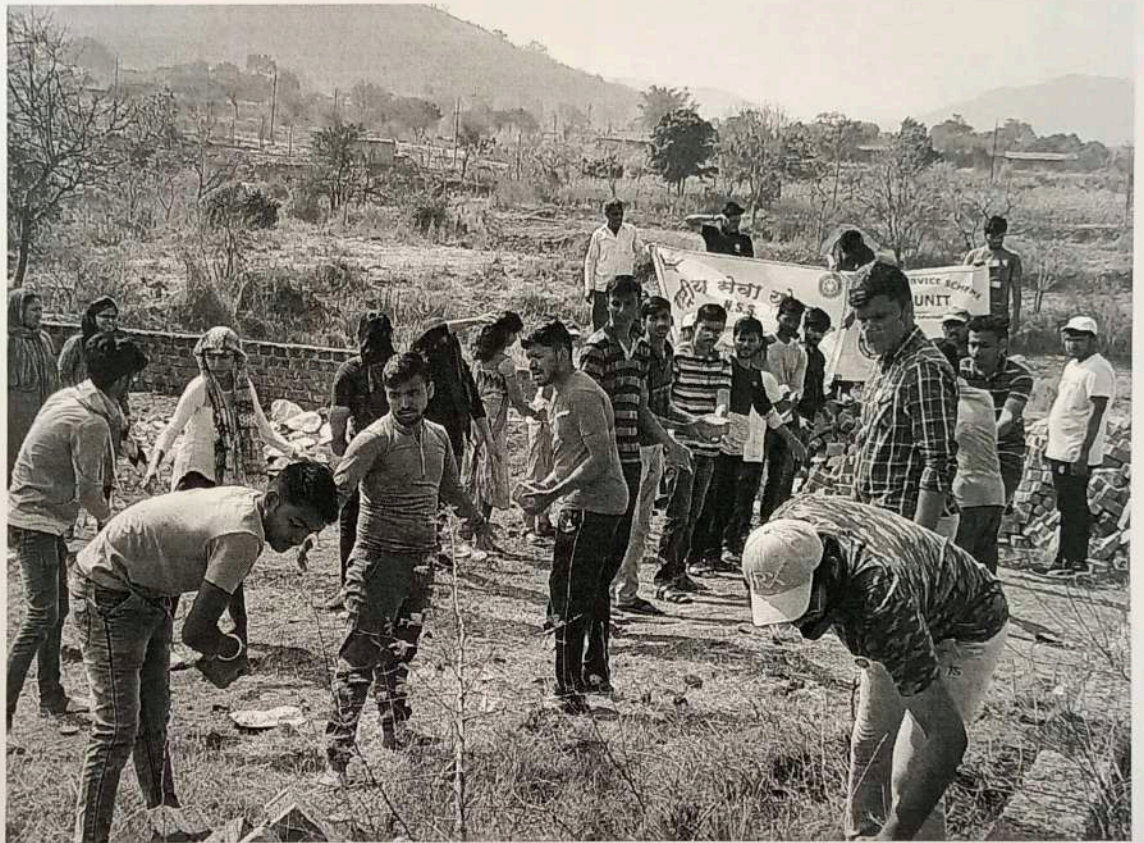
On 28<sup>th</sup> of February was reserved for the tracking at Wagheshwar Hill near Aadhale Khurd. NSS Volunteers have carried utensils for the Maha-Shivratri Pooja. The NSS Volunteers were divided into 5 groups of 10 NSS Volunteers and each group dug 10 pits of 2 ft × 2 ft. so total 50 pits are ready for the plantation activity. The plantation activity will be done in coming monsoon season by villagers and NSS Volunteers. The villagers have arranged lunch for all NSS Volunteers after this activity.

The main objective of this trek was to create awareness about conservation of nature by planting trees. This task was successfully completed by the unit of NSS. At the end of the day everyone was happy and feeling proud about the day activity.

NSS Volunteers were divided into pairs and each pair had to take survey of around 10 families.

The mentors were helping the NSS Volunteers for this survey.

This was a great experience to interact with the villagers as they were very friendly, and the task completed perfectly.



# Kitchen Activities

During 7 days of NSS camp each group of 10 NSS Volunteers was assigned the daily cooking task. The group has the responsibility to plan for Breakfast/lunch/dinner for the day, also volunteers must plan what to cook and availability of ingredients. One group of volunteers were planning of washing of cloth and cleaning of utensils.

Cooking activity starts in the morning for breakfast which must be ready by 8:00a.m, followed by the morning tea. Then it was time for the preparation of lunch by 1p.m and evening tea at 5.00p.m. The day ends up by 8.30p.m. after dinner.

It was a fun day for all the group members as everyone was actively participating and helping each other. Cutting vegetables, serving other group members and teachers, washing utensils, cleaning cooking area, checking availability of drinking water, bringing milk were the activities to be done in a daytime.

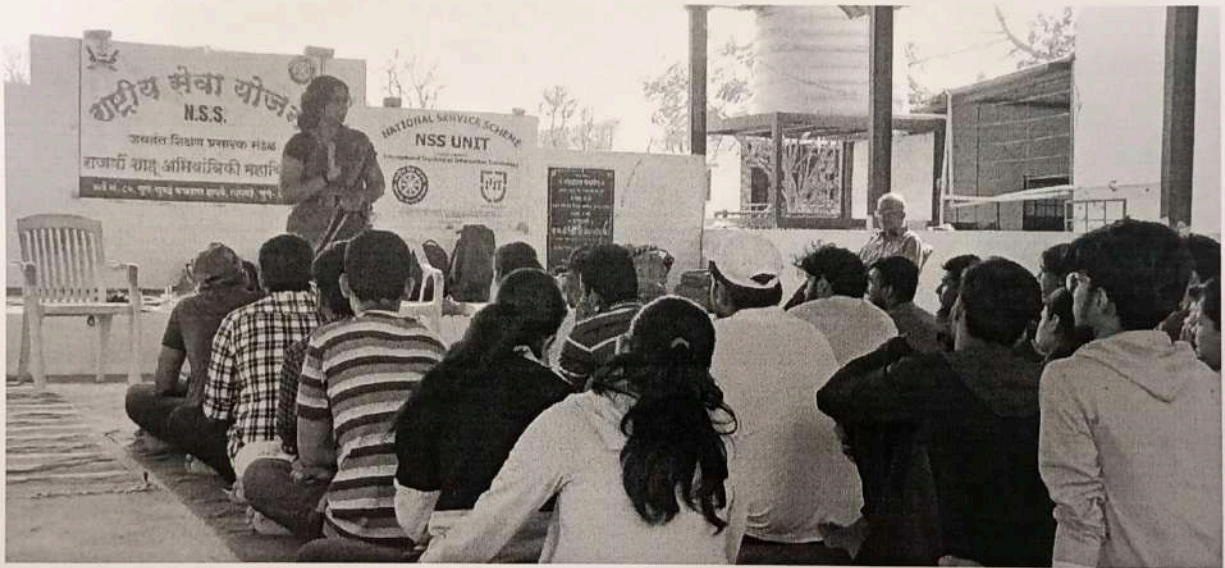
On 28/02/22, Prof. Mahadev waghmare cheered us by talking about "Chant of Happy Life".

On 03/03/22, Dr. Dubal Madam has conducted one lecture about development of women and career path for women and also thrown light on superstition.



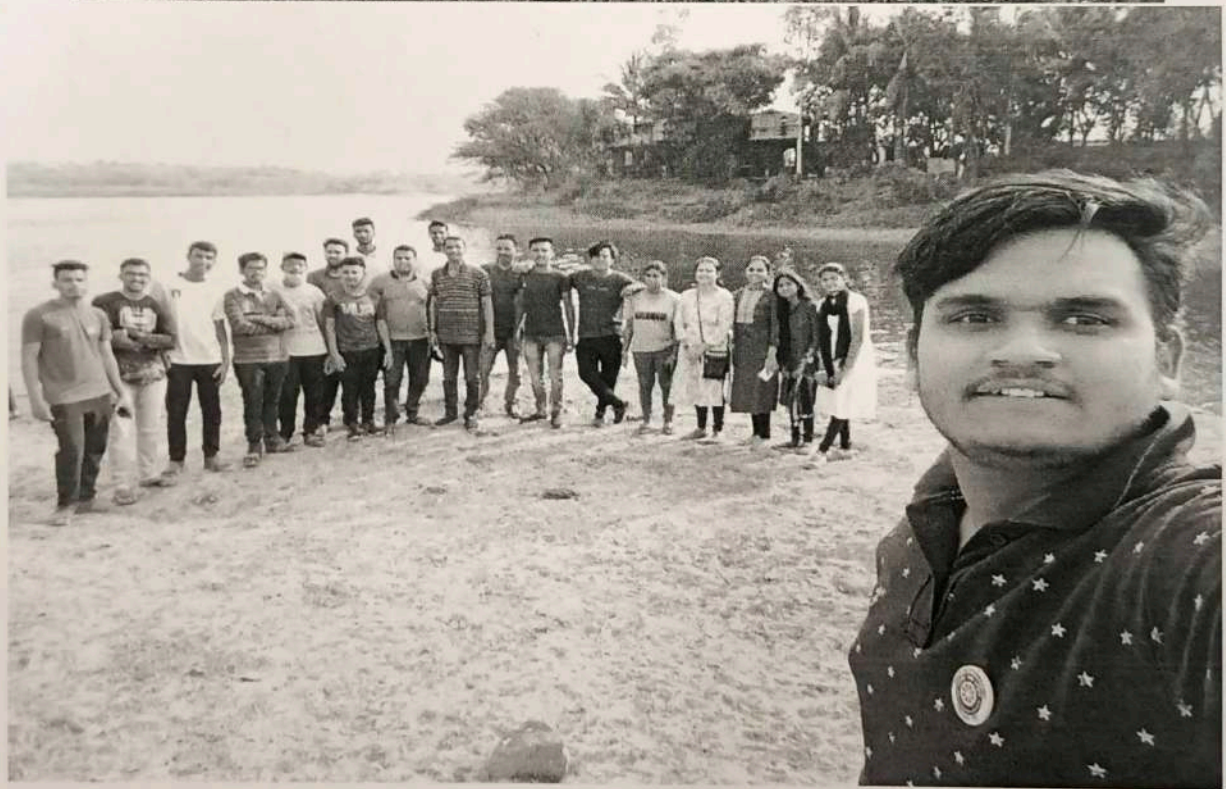




## VISIT TO PAWANA RIVER SIDE”

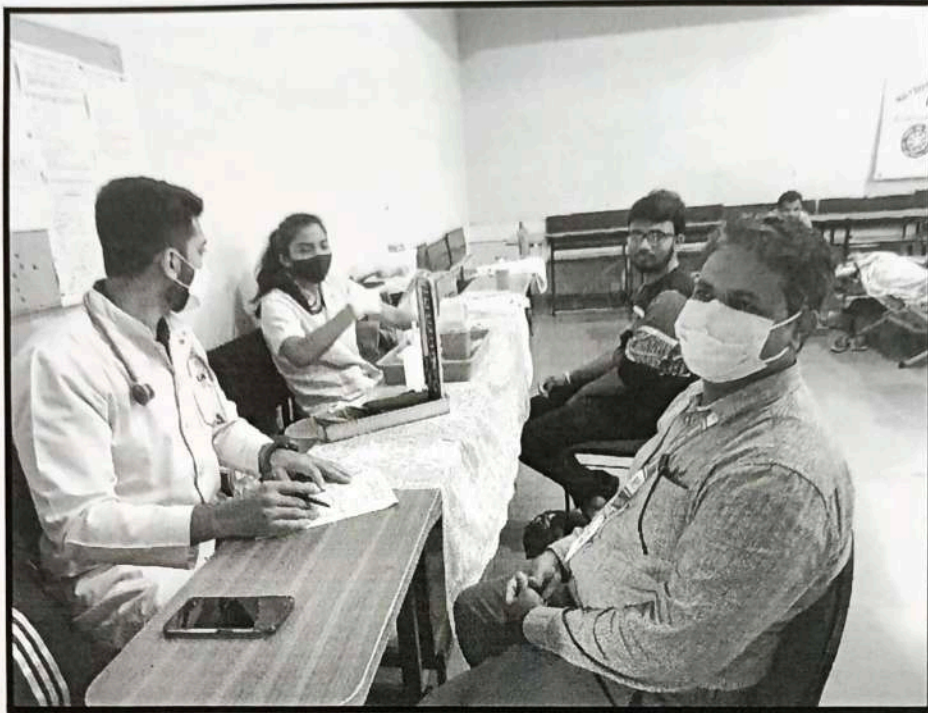

### **Activity Description in Nutshell:**

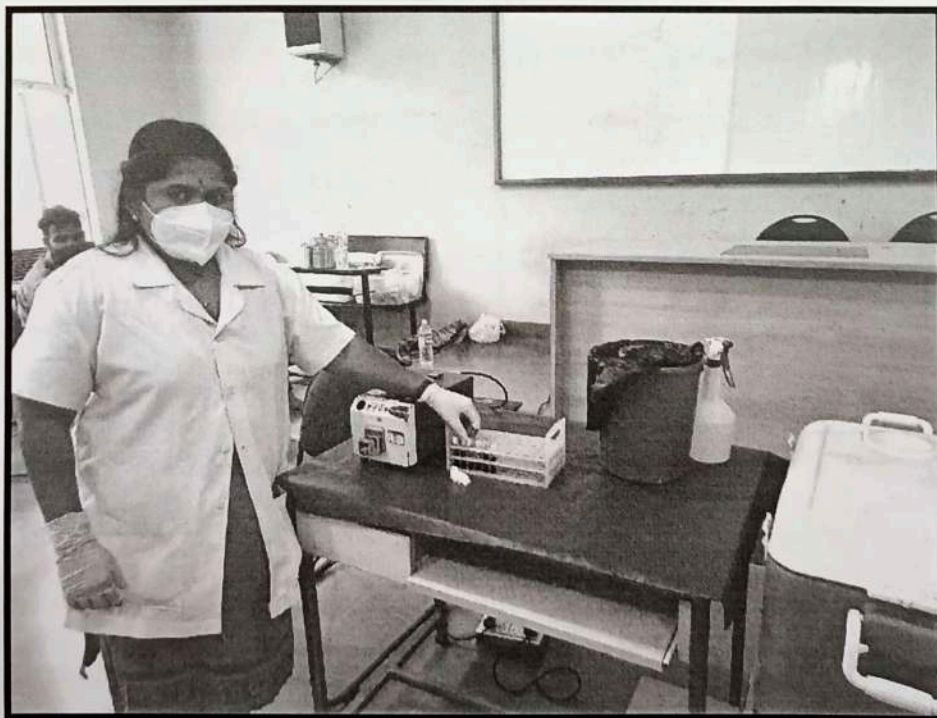

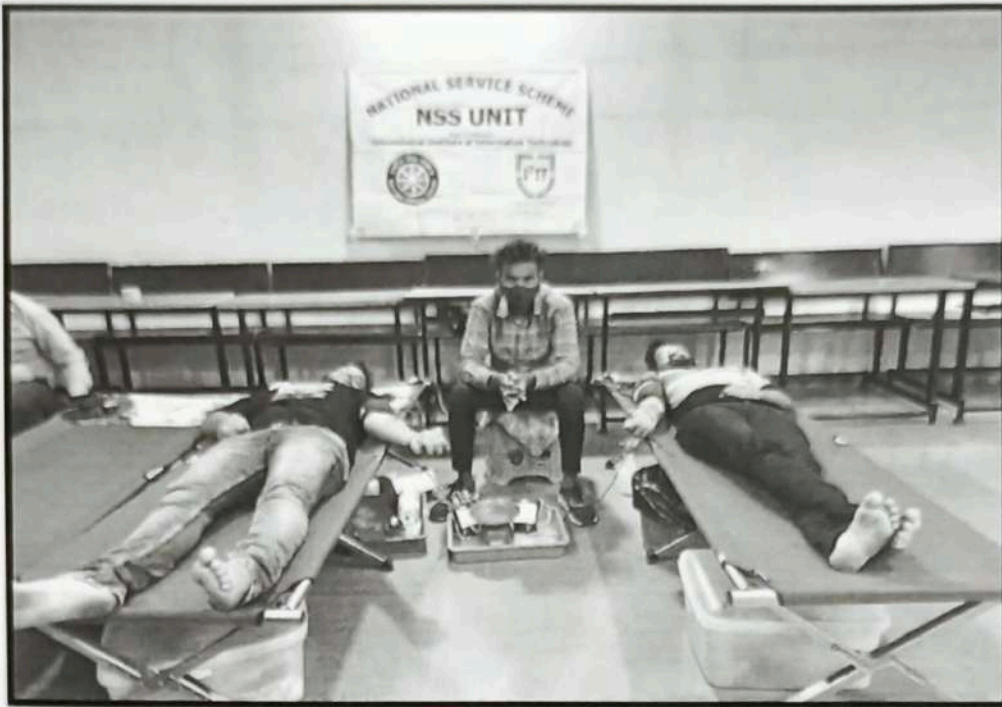

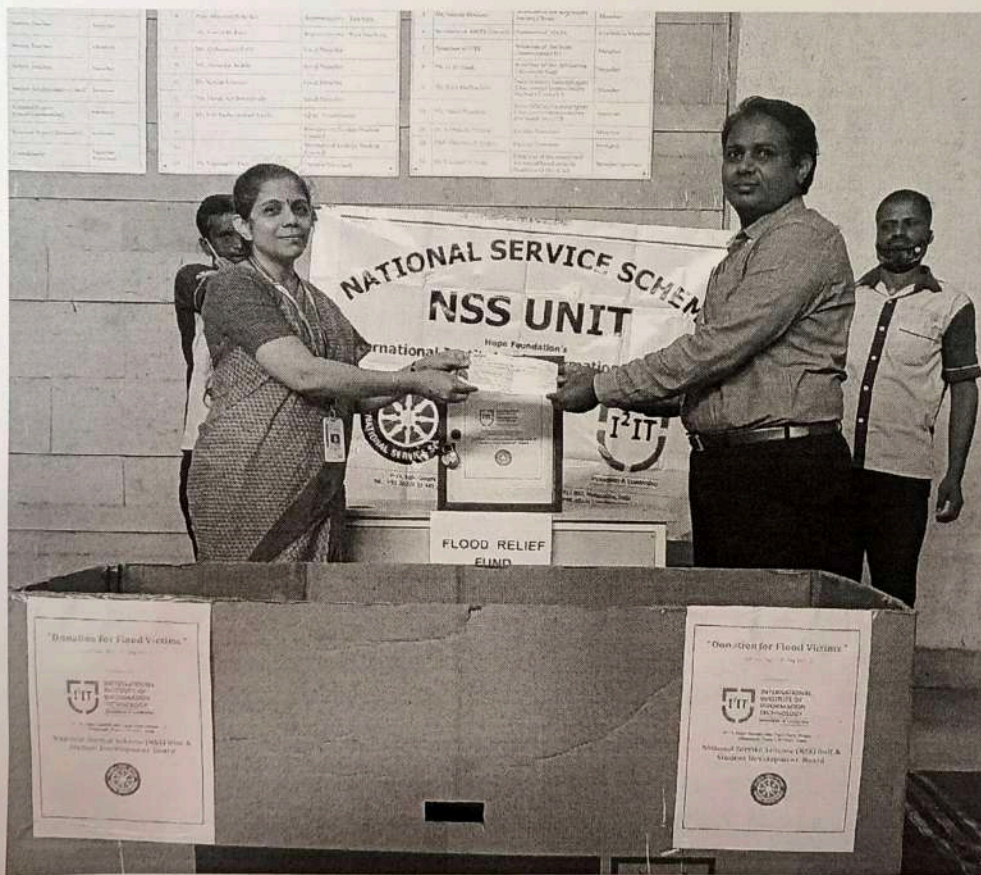

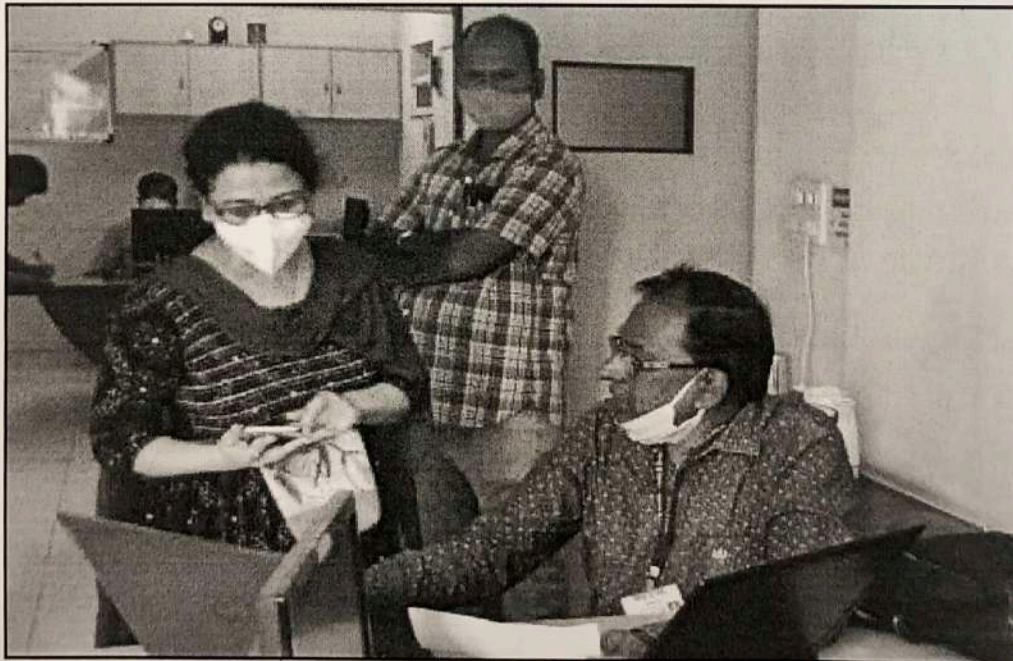
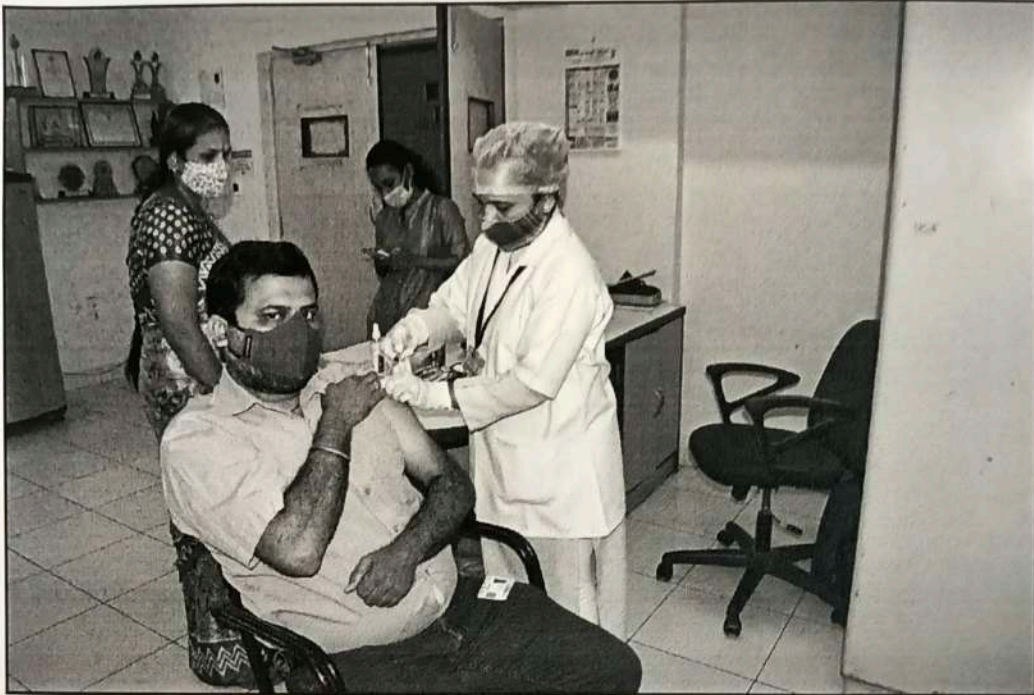


Photo 1: Registration for vaccination

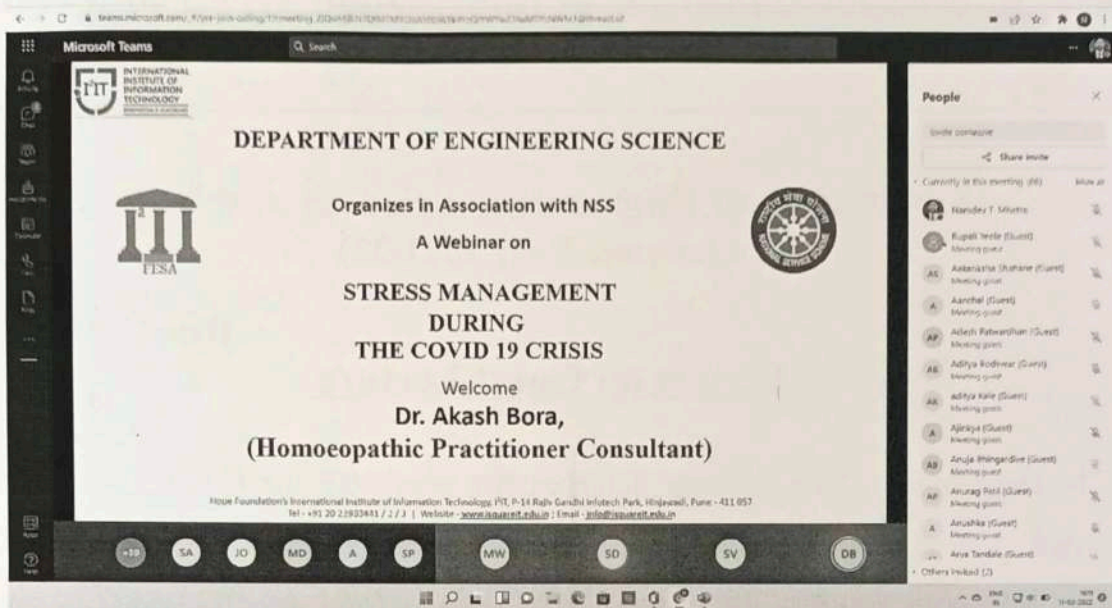


Photo 1: “A Guest Lecture on “Basic concept & methods of partial differentiation”

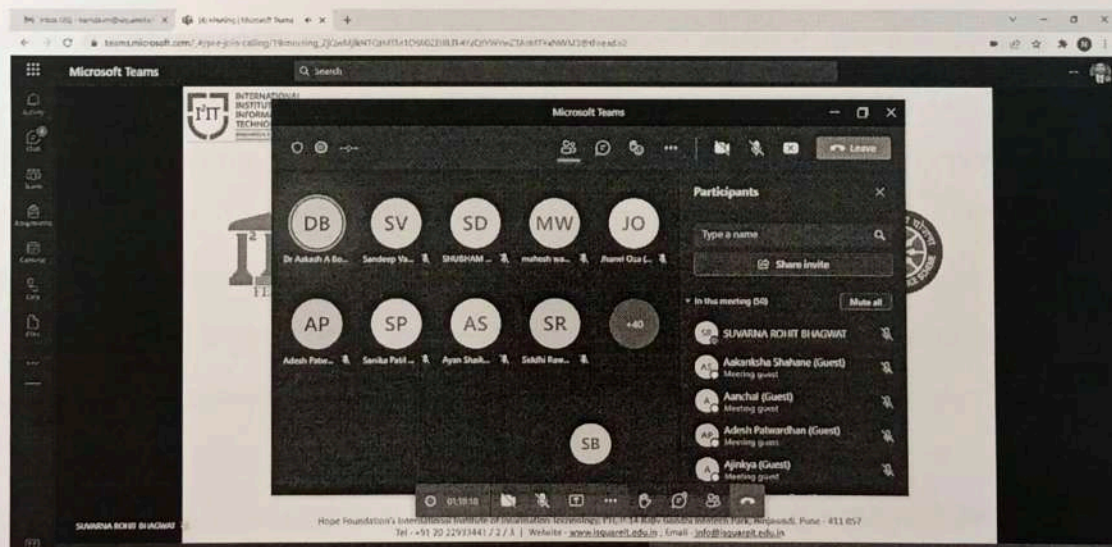

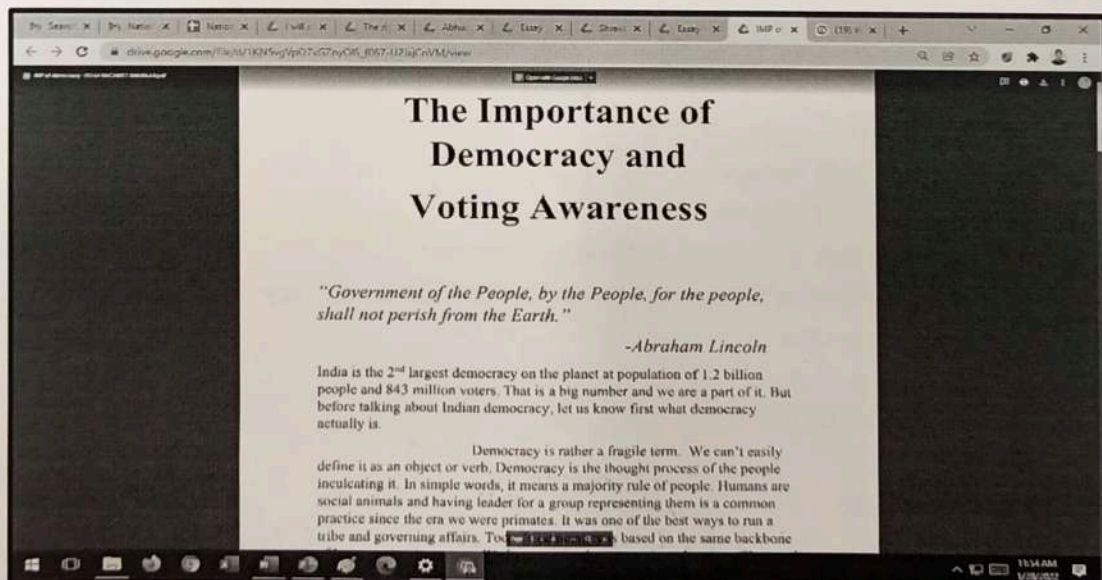

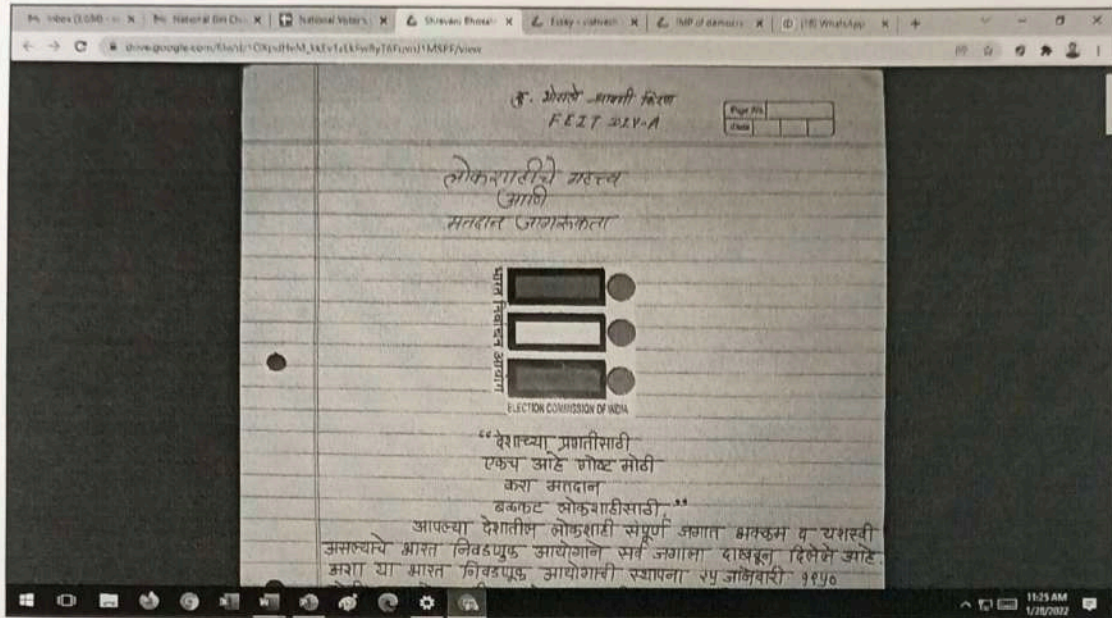
