In accordance with the desire to promote cooperation in Education, Training, Research & Development and sharing of knowledge on a mutual basis, the **Audyogik Tantra Shikshan Sanstha's Institute of Industrial and Computer Management and Research (ATSS – IICMR), Pune** and **Hope Foundation's, International Institute of Information Technology (I<sup>2</sup>IT), Pune** hereby enter into an agreement to establish a program for cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this Memorandum of Understanding (the Agreement).

([www.isquareit.edu.in](http://www.isquareit.edu.in)).

Established in the year 2011, I<sup>2</sup>IT is committed to grow on a path of delivering distinctive high-quality education, fostering research, creativity and discovery. The Institute is approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi; recognized by Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Govt. of Maharashtra; and affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University. Currently, the Institute offers Bachelor of Engineering (B. E.) courses in Electronics and Telecommunication, Computer Engineering, and Information Technology.

**A. Objectives**

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish a partnership to further the mutual interests and to foster and develop cooperation between the two organizations in accordance with their individual mission and objectives, especially in respect of conduct of training programs & research. Towards this

**IICMR and I<sup>2</sup>IT agree:**

1. Carrying out research activities in collaboration.
2. Following will be followed for AWS Training:
  - a. Prof. Bailappa Bhovi, AWS Certified Educator will train the students of IICMR on AWS Cloud Practitioner & Solutions Architect through AWS Academy Platform. Training will be based on Instructor-led online & offline blended mode of teaching & learning pedagogies.
  - b. IICMR will pay INR 1500 per candidate to enroll for AWS cloud Practitioner course and INR 3500 per candidate to enroll into AWS Solutions Architect course.
  - c. Registered students will be given access to AWS Academy Canvas Platform's online content, which includes videos, study materials with hands-on labs and knowledge checks.
  - d. Payment shall be transferred to I<sup>2</sup>IT bank account within 10 days of course initialization.
  - e. Global Certification exams on AWS cloud Practitioner exam costs \$100 and AWS Solutions Architect exam costs \$150 plus GST. AWS Academy will provide a 50% discount vouchers on these exam fees to all the students enrolled for the above courses.

I2IT will confirm by email on receipt of such payments.

Each of the collaborative activities identified above will be subject to separate contractual agreements which will be agreed by the two institutions and be subject to regular and specified review procedures. These agreements shall include a brief description of the proposed activity, the person(s) responsible for its implementation, and financial arrangements etc.

**B. Coordination**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research functions to coordinate the program on its behalf. They will provide such academic and administrative support as may be required for the purpose of settling any issues arising during the effective term of this agreement and shall supervise the activities conducted under this Agreement. The coordinators along with other nominated persons will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

**C. Duration of the Agreement**

This Agreement will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and mutual agreement.

Either party may terminate the Agreement by giving written notice of not less than 30 (thirty) days' notice to expire on the proposed termination date. The revocation of the MoU shall only be prospective and will not affect the rights/obligations arising out of acts done/occurred prior to the termination of the MOU.

**D. Publicity**

While this MOU remains in force, both the parties shall have the right to use logos of each other's in their promotional and other materials as and when required. Both parties also have the right to mention about this collaboration in public media.

**E. No Legal Obligations**


The parties agree that the provisions contained in this MoU do not create any legal obligations between the Parties.


**F. Confidentiality**

Any information obtained by either Party hereto about the other pursuant to the implementation of this MOU shall be treated and maintained by the receiving Party as strictly confidential, and the receiving Party shall not use the information obtained for any purpose other than the purpose stated in the foregoing paragraphs; and such information shall not be directly or indirectly transmitted to or discussed with any third person or party of the other Party without the prior written consent of the other party. This clause shall survive the termination of the MOU.



Hope Foundation's International Institute of Information Technology (I<sup>2</sup>IT) herein after referred to as "I<sup>2</sup>IT" having its office at P-14, Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Phase – 1 Hinjewadi, Pune - 411057 is a premier educational and research institution located in the InfoTech Park in the Knowledge city of Pune in India. ([www.isquareit.edu.in](http://www.isquareit.edu.in)). Established in the year 2011, I<sup>2</sup>IT is committed to grow on a path of delivering distinctive high-quality education, fostering research, outreach, creativity and discovery. The Institute is approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi; recognized by Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Govt. of Maharashtra; and affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University. Currently, the Institute offers Bachelor of Engineering (B. E.) courses in Electronics and Telecommunication, Computer Engineering, and Information Technology.

Hereinafter, FIR and I<sup>2</sup>IT are each referred to as "Party", collectively as "Parties".

## 1. Purpose

This MOU is intended to summarize the current business understanding of the Parties for the purposes of developing skill building programs in the areas of Artificial Intelligence,

Cyber Security and Cloud Computing, Geo-informatics and IoT through sharing knowledge, research, innovations and skilled resources in the interest of mutual benefit in the area of development and deployment of:

- a) Smart Initiatives in Urban, Rural and Industrial environment
- b) Green Energy Transformation and it's optimal utilization.
- c) Bio-Technology initiatives.
- d) Industrial Research & Development projects (hereinafter referred to as the "Project").

New Project in other areas can be considered as per the requirement and approval from both the parties.

Whereas FIR is interested in building synergy and extending supports through knowledge, experience and expertise available with FIR through their eminent resources for the proposed Project to be developed and implemented through various educational and transformation processes and has expressed its interest to support I<sup>2</sup>IT for successful implementation of processes for the Project.



Whereas I<sup>2</sup>IT is also interested in extending their knowledge, experience and expertise services and also has intention to develop and implement the project through various educational and transformational processes and also to provide advisory services and deployment supports, to develop Project for the Urban Local Bodies, Government Departments, their companies or subsidiaries and public/private sector companies/Individual entrepreneurs or scholars/innovators through FIR.

## 2. Co-operation

The following items, without limitation, shall be defined and agreed upon by the Parties for this MOU:

- a) Knowledge, Research, Development of the Project through various methods and mechanisms.
- b) Transformation and deployment and advisory services for the Project.
- c) Collaborate on efforts to implement,
- d) Cooperation on other matters that are of mutual interest.
- e) Exchange of information and human resources without infringing the IPR Rights of individual or institution or industry involved in the Project.

## 3. Non-Binding

Except for Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, this MOU is legally non-binding and does not create legal rights or obligations on the part of either Party.

## 4. Costs

Each Party shall bear its own costs in relation to the performance of their respective obligations under this MOU. Indian or International travel cost will be borne by the respective parties for persons deputed by them including local logistics, accommodation and travel. In case any staff /resource of foreign collaborative agency visits I<sup>2</sup>IT for specific program specially designed for the I<sup>2</sup>IT, all expenditure of invitee for the local logistics, accommodation and travel shall be borne by I<sup>2</sup>IT.

## 5. Fees

- a) I<sup>2</sup>IT shall register every new project with FIR by paying an initial prescribed project registration fees of Rs. 500.



- b) Once the project is registered and mentors/ subject experts are assigned, a project supervision fees shall be worked out by FIR considering the involvement Time and Supports and I<sup>2</sup>IT shall pay the same before starting the actual work on the project.

The Fees structure will be decided by FIR and applicable for the specific period for specific project.

#### **6. Restrictions**

I<sup>2</sup>IT shall not deal directly with any party or institution or organisation they are introduced through FIR without written consent from Secretary, FIR.

#### **7. Term and Termination**

This MOU shall become effective as of the Effective Date and remain in force for a period of Five (5) years and can be renewed with one (1) month prior written notice

Either Party may terminate this MOU without any cost and liability by one (1) month prior written notice.

#### **8. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution**

This MOU shall be governed and construed by the laws of Indian Central Governments and State Governments, without reference to conflict of law principles.

All disputes arising out of or in any manner relating to this MOU shall be resolved between the Parties within fifteen (15) days. If not, such dispute or controversy shall be finally settled by the Arbitration Authority in accordance with the arbitration rules thereof, and the arbitration shall be held in English language. The arbitration award shall be final and binding, and a judgment consistent therewith may be entered by any court of competent jurisdiction of Pune.

#### **9. Confidentiality**

During the term of this MOU and for so long as such information remains confidential, both Parties agree that no Party hereto may use, disclose and/or release, any of disclosing Party's information which was disclosed pursuant to activities in connection with this MOU, to any third party (except as required as part of its activities under this MOU) without the prior written consent of such disclosing Party.

#### **10. Intellectual Property Rights**

During the term of this MOU and after that also both the parties will honor the Intellectual Property Rights already possessed by either of the party and shall not infringe them and









course of working together if any Intellectual Property right/rights created will be registered Jointly by creating mutual understanding.

#### 11. Amendment

No amendment, variation or modification of any provisions of this MOU shall be effective unless made with the prior written agreement of both Parties.

#### **Scope of Work – I2IT**

I2IT agrees to provide *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* facilities such as classrooms & other required infrastructure, including but not limited to, projector, screen, Internet, Audio/visual facility, flip charts and markers to give training to the students.

#### **Obligation of Work – The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd**

Either Party shall not use logos, trademarks, trade names or intellectual property of other Party for any other purpose as enshrined under this MOU without prior written approval from other Party.

1. Either Party shall ensure that nothing is done or omitted to be done by them which may affect the reputation of other Party or its intellectual property.
2. The Parties hereto agree that they are independent contractors. Nothing contained herein shall construe either Party as an agent, legal representative, partner, subsidiary or employee of the other.
3. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of 60 (sixty) days / (2) months to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.
4. In case of termination of this MOU, *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* agrees to fulfil their commitments towards the enrolled students and to complete the remaining training for the particular semester.

5. All claims, disputes, differences or disagreements of whatsoever nature arising out of, in connection with or in relation to this MOU whether during its term or after expiry thereof or prior termination, shall be finally decided by arbitration to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 in force as at the date of the invocation of the arbitration. Parties mutually agree to refer their disputes to the sole arbitration of a mutually agreed person, whose decision and award shall be final and binding between the Parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Pune, Maharashtra.
6. Courts in Pune shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle all disputes and differences arising out of this MOU, whether during its term or after expiry / earlier termination thereof.
7. Both the Parties shall indemnify and hold each other harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees.
8. Any notice/letter/correspondence either through registered post/courier/fax shall be delivered /served at the business address of the Parties.
9. Each Party shall bear its own legal, and other costs, charges and expenses connected with the negotiation, preparation and execution of this MOU or any other agreement incidental to or referred to in this MOU.
10. This MOU may not be amended or modified except by an instrument in writing signed only by the authorised signatories on behalf of both the Parties. In witness whereof, both Parties put their hardseal on the day, month and year herein mentioned.
11. Profiles of the concerned faculty in terms of their qualifications and experience shall be provided by *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* and shall be agreed upon by I2IT prior to start of training for a particular semester.
12. *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* should not depute faculty other than the ones approved by I2IT.




13. Professional ethics, code of conduct and disciplinary approach shall be maintained by *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* faculty towards students at all the times. Any misbehaviour by *The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd* faculty shall attract immediate replacement of the concerned trainer.
14. Faculty from The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd may be evaluated by senior faculty from I2IT in terms of delivery and contents of the sessions. Appropriate written feedback will be provided to The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd in case of improvement required. The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd will take necessary steps to ensure that corrective actions are taken.
15. The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd faculty will also be evaluated by students by way of “online” feedback mechanism and minimum expected feedback is 7 (on a scale of 10).
16. Both the Parties may address the issue of providing joint participation / completion certificates to the enrolled students after successful completion of the program.

1. I2IT may receive information proprietary to The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd and vice versa (the “Confidential Information”) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by I<sup>2</sup>IT / The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd from third Parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in I<sup>2</sup>IT / The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd possession and was lawfully received from sources other than The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd and Institute or (d) is independently developed by Institute/ The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd .
2. The two Parties understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust, to be disclosed only to such persons as have a “need to know” the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the I<sup>2</sup>IT/ The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd for the benefit of others.
3. All information or correspondence including information shared with or exchanged by The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd the I<sup>2</sup>IT or any of its employees, agents, officers, directors and contractors in connection with this MOU including all training materials, training content & methodologies, classroom & trainer notes, assessment tests etc. will be the sole and absolute property of The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd including intellectual property and proprietary rights.

4. Either Party shall not use logos, trademarks, trade name or intellectual property of other Party for any other purpose as enshrined under this MOU without prior written approval from other Party. I2IT agrees and confirms that during the term of this engagement and for a minimum period of twenty four (24) months after termination or expiration for any reason of this agreement, shall not engage, directly or indirectly, or assist any other party in hiring any person employed or hired as an employee by The GATE Academy Pvt. Ltd, who is directly or indirectly associated with the project.

### **Scope of collaboration – Department of E&TC**

2. Either Party shall ensure that nothing is done or omitted to be done by them which may affect the reputation of other Party or its intellectual property.





3. The Parties hereto agree that they are independent contractors. Nothing contained herein shall construe either Party as an agent, legal representative, partner, subsidiary or employee of the other.
4. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MoU with a written notice period of 60 (sixty) days / (2) months to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.
5. In case of termination of this MoU, *Apvike Ltd.* agrees to fulfil their commitments towards the enrolled students and to complete the remaining training for the particular semester.
6. All claims, disputes, differences or disagreements of whatsoever nature arising out of, in connection with or in relation to this MoU whether during its term or after expiry thereof or prior termination, shall be finally decided by arbitration to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 in force as at the date of the invocation of the arbitration. Parties mutually agree to refer their disputes to the sole arbitration of a mutually agreed person, whose decision and award shall be final and binding between the Parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Pune, Maharashtra.
7. Courts in Pune shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle all disputes and differences arising out of this MoU, whether during its term or after expiry / earlier termination thereof.
8. Both the Parties shall indemnify and hold each other harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees.
9. Any notice/letter/correspondence either through registered post/ courier/ fax shall be delivered /served at the business address of the Parties.
10. Each Party shall bear its own legal, and other costs, charges and expenses connected with the negotiation, preparation and execution of this MoU or any other agreement incidental to or referred to in this MoU.
11. This MoU may not be amended or modified except by an instrument in writing signed only by the authorised signatories on behalf of both the Parties. In witness whereof, both Parties put their hard seal on the day, month and year herein mentioned.

#### **Obligation of Work – Department of E&TC**

1. Department of E&TC may receive information proprietary to *Apvike Ltd.* and vice versa (the “Confidential Information”) in the course of performance of their obligations under this

MoU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by Department of Information Technology /Bharat Information Technology (Pune) Pvt. Ltd from third Parties without accompanying secrecy obligations



already in Department of E&TC/ *Apvike Ltd.* possession and was lawfully received from sources other than *Apvike Ltd.* and Institute or (d) is independently developed by Institute/ *Apvike Ltd.*

2. The two Parties understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust, to be disclosed only to such persons as have a “need to know” the same for the effective implementation of this MoU and that it will only be used by the Dept of E&TC/ *Apvike Ltd.* for the benefit of others.
3. All information or correspondence including information shared with or exchanged by *Apvike Ltd.* or the Department of E&TC or any of its employees, agents, officers, directors and contractors in connection with this MoU will be the sole and absolute property of *Apvike Ltd.* or the Institute including intellectual property and proprietary rights.
4. Either Party shall not use logos, trademarks, trade name or intellectual property of other Party for any other purpose as enshrined under this MoU without prior written approval from other party. Department of E&TC agrees and confirms that during the term of this engagement and for a minimum period of twenty-four (24) months after termination or expiration for any reason of this agreement, shall not engage, directly or indirectly, or assist any other party in hiring any person employed or hired as an employee by *Apvike Ltd.*, who is directly or indirectly associated with the project.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This *MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING* (MOU) is entered into and is effective as on the date of the signatures:

Between

**IEEE Pune Section, Pune**, a non-profit professional organization, hereinafter termed as **IEEE**, having, its address at PICT, Survey no. 27, Near Trimurti Chowk, Dhanakawdi, Pune-411 003 (Maharashtra- India).

And

**Hope Foundation's International Institute of Information Technology (I<sup>2</sup>IT), Pune** has its address at P-14, Rajiv Gandhi, Infotech Park, Hinjawadi, Pune, 411057 (Maharashtra- India) hereinafter termed as **I<sup>2</sup>IT**.

IEEE and I<sup>2</sup>IT, Pune shall be known collectively as “the Parties” and singularly as “a Party” or “the Party.”

### Context

IEEE (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers), is the world's largest technical professional organization working for the advancement of technology. IEEE's core purpose is to foster technological innovation and excellence for the benefit of humanity. It operates across the globe through its various sections. IEEE Pune Section is one of the active sections under Region 10 of IEEE having its jurisdiction in and around the city of Pune. Multiple initiatives are driven by IEEE Pune Section for the benefit of the community and all such activities are managed by its Execom (Executive committee) the apex body of the section. One such key initiative of the IEEE Pune Section is the Special Interest Group (SIG) for Affordable Agriculture hereinafter referred to as SIG. The mission of the SIG is to “Create an ecosystem to nurture innovation for benefit of the farming community” and it is working towards encouraging engineering students to take up technology projects to address challenges in the agriculture domain. The students are expected to empathetically understand farmers' requirements and address those using innovative, digital, frugal and interdisciplinary solutions. SIG will also encourage youth to take up careers in Agriculture and help evolve suitable models to enhance the income levels of farmers.



Multiple leading engineering institutes across Maharashtra have expressed interest in becoming a part of the SIG. This MOU is being signed to formalize this partnership between IEEE Pune Section and the respective institutes.

The parties of this Agreement indicate their willingness in principle to cooperate for creating a favorable and collaborative ecosystem for executing innovative technical projects for the benefit of the agriculture domain. Under this agreement, the types of cooperation may include:

1. Making faculty members available for lectures, joint research and sharing of experience & best practices;
2. Organizing workshops, seminars and expert talks either by IEEE or Institute to enhance technical & agriculture domain knowledge of the students & faculty members.
3. Enabling expert advice for setting up an "Affordable Agriculture lab" in the institute.
4. Providing facilities on farms for testing solutions created by students by leveraging its network.
5. Nominating students for various events organized by IEEE for the benefit of students and faculty such as exhibitions and study tours.
6. Enabling funding based on availability for relevant activities taken up by institutes.
7. Other relevant activities as mutually agreed.

### **Financial Terms**

The funding of activities related to this agreement will be determined at the time a specific project is approved by both parties as a part of a written agreement. Both IEEE and Institute understand that all financial arrangements which are negotiated will depend on the availability of funds. The institute shall submit a utilization certificate (Signed by Principal and/or Auditor) along with supporting bills for all expenses incurred using grants given by IEEE.

To implement the collaborative activities envisaged under this MOU, representative of the Parties may meet periodically to negotiate and conclude specific project agreements and programs of cooperation, including the terms for their financing, with each other and with other parties provided that neither Party shall have the power to bind the other Party without the other Party's consent in writing.

The financial arrangement relating to each collaborative activity will be in accordance with the specific project agreement and program of cooperation covering each collaborative activity. The Parties agree that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses, including but not limited to, salary, travel, living and allied cost relating to each collaborative activity shall be borne by the Party who incurs such expenses.

### **Duration of Agreement**

This agreement will be operative for a period of two years. Towards the end of the second year, the agreement will be reviewed. This agreement can be terminated by either party by 60 days written notification.

### **Management Committee**

The Parties can appoint representatives to manage and oversee the collaborative activities contemplated under this MOU. The representative of the Parties can meet as and when necessary to review progress in the implementation of activities related to the areas of collaboration, define new areas and programs of collaboration as well as discuss matters related to this MOU.



## **Intellectual Property, Inventions and Innovations**

All intellectual property held by a Party prior to entering into this MOU or disclosed or introduced in connection with this MOU and all materials in which such intellectual property is held, disclosed or introduced shall remain the property of the Party introducing or disclosing it.

All Intellectual Property created as a part of the projects that are executed as part of this MOU will be owned by the students or the Institute in accordance with the policies of the Institute.

## **Publication of Articles**

Each party may, with the written consent of the other party, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld, publish the findings of the collaborative activities of the Parties in the form of an article in a journal, newspaper or other magazines, provided that where an application for registration of a trademark, service mark or design, or an application for a patent, will be made, such an article shall not be published for a period of up to ninety (90) days for the said application to be made. A copy of the article to be published shall be provided to the Party whose written consent is required hereunder prior to publication of the same for that Party's perusal and written consent.

## **Representation to the Public and Confidentiality**

- a. Neither party shall use the name or logo of the other party for any purpose whether in relation to any advertisement or other form of publicity without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party.
- b. Notwithstanding the generality of the above, the parties may notify third parties of the fact that this MOU is in effect.
- c. All information furnished in relation to this MOU by one party to the other, which is clearly identified as proprietary or confidential at the time of disclosure, will be kept confidential by the receiving party, and will not be disclosed to any third party otherwise than to carry out the provision of this MOU; unless agreed in writing between the parties.
- d. The provisions of clause 'c' above will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.
- e. Clauses c, d and e will survive the expiry or termination of this MOU for one (1) year from the date of expiry or termination of this MOU.

## **Amendments**

This MOU may be amended and supplemented in writing at any time by the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.

## **Term of MOU**

This MOU shall commence on the effective date and shall remain in force for a period of two years. Thereafter, the MOU can be renewed by mutual consent of both Parties. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of the projects or programs established under it prior to such termination.





### Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising under or in connection with this MOU which cannot be resolved by amicable discussions between the Parties shall be referred to the Presidents/Vice-Chancellors of the respective parties or their nominees for resolution or may be submitted to such alternative dispute resolution mechanism as may be agreed in writing between the parties.

### Non-binding Nature of this MOU

This MOU is a non-binding expression of the current intension of the Parties, and neither Party will incur nor be bound to any legal obligations or expenses hereunder to the other party until and unless definitive agreements have been negotiated, approved by the necessary management levels of each party and executed and delivered by authorized representatives of both parties.


Following clauses shall survive the expiry or termination of this MOU and shall be legally enforceable in accordance with their terms in any court of competent jurisdiction.

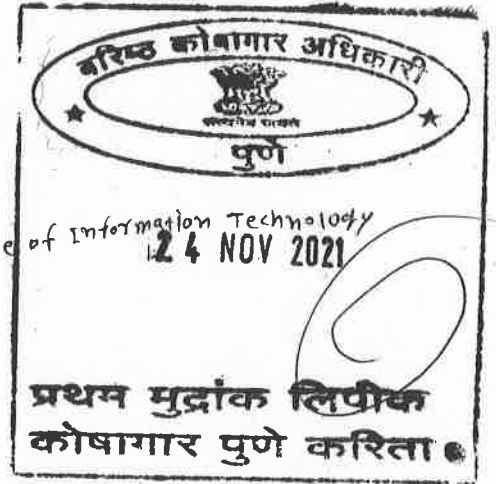

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This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into on 10th December 2021, BY AND BETWEEN, 27<sup>th</sup>

**The Student Promise Ltd**, a legal entity under the laws of the United Kingdom (private limited company), having its registered office in Cardiff, Wales, and its principal place of business at Lichttoren 32, 5611 BJ Eindhoven, the Netherlands, duly represented by its director Esther Heymans or its authorised representative Gerard Ackermans, hereinafter to be referred to as: 'The Student Promise';

In India we have appointed our authorised representative as Ankit Rai, employed through WorldEmp India Private Limited with registered office address as: #501, Level 05, Pentagon, Tower P-2, Magarpatta City, Hadapsar, Pune 411013, Maharashtra, India.

AND

**International Institute of Information Technology (PIT)**, having its registered office in Pune and its principal place of business at P-14, MIDC Phase 1, Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Hinjawadi, Maharashtra 411057, India, duly represented by its spokesperson Dr. Risil Chhatrala, hereinafter to be referred to as: 'PIT';

Whereas:

- PIT is an educational institution that offers high-quality education to the students who study at its institution and who are registered as such with it;
- PIT intends to prepare its students, among other things, for their professional and social career, and is always looking for options to increase the opportunities of students in their social and professional career and to make optimum use of the student's potential;
- The Student Promise helps students to prepare them for the next step in their life, the first step in their career. This generation wants a job to realise their ambitions. They want to go on an adventure and show what they are really worth. The Student Promise is the platform that puts the student back in control. The Student Promise takes them on a journey to help them find out what works for them. The Student Promise makes ambitions possible, so they can get the most out of themselves in their job. "The Student Promise, Be All That You Can Be.";
- The Student Promise has presented this concept to PIT, and PIT has become interested about the concept;

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- PIT is willing to contribute to the further sharing of the concept for its students, and to actively bring the concept to its students' attention.
- The parties intend to cooperate in the context of promoting The Student Promise and to share information with each other in that context;
- The parties wish to record this cooperation in broad outline, and it is the parties' intention to expand this cooperation in the near future and in case of proven added value, in which case more detailed arrangements will be made regarding individual topics;

*which is why the parties have agreed as follows:*

#### **Article 1: The objective of the cooperation**

The objective of this MOU is to make arrangements in broad outline aimed at the cooperation between the parties concerning the marketing of the concept of The Student Promise.

PIT is the intended ambassador of The Student Promise.

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#### **Article 4: Liability**

Each party is responsible for the correct fulfilment of its obligations under this MOU in good time.

#### **Article 5: Consultation**

The parties will put together a project team, also with a view to the good performance of the arrangements made in this cooperation MOU. More detailed arrangements will be made about the composition of the project team, but each of the parties will in any case have one representative take part in the project team.

#### **Article 6: Costs and Income**

Each party bears its own costs to the extent that such costs are necessary to realise the objective of the cooperation as formulated above. At a later stage, the parties will make arrangements about any income resulting from the cooperation and the division thereof in case of any joint events which has generated any amount of funds for the parties. None of the parties have any financial obligation towards each other during the entire term of this MOU.

#### **Article 7: Non-disclosure**

The parties undertake towards each other that they will keep secret all commercial data and market data, employee data and student data and other business confidential data, as well as those data in respect of which one of the parties has indicated the confidential nature in writing or the confidential nature of which the parties should understand. The parties will only use the information disclosed to each other with a view to the objective of the cooperation. This non-disclosure obligation applies up to two years after the cooperation has ended.

The obligations stated above do not apply to information

- (a) that is currently known to one of the parties, which will be demonstrated by means of submission of any written documentation in that regard that exists and is in the possession of the relevant party at this time, unless a non-disclosure obligation in respect of third parties applies to this information,
- (b) that is currently generally known, which will be demonstrated by means of submission of any written documentation in that regard that exists at this time,
- (c) which becomes generally known after commencement of the cooperation, which will be demonstrated by means of written documentation in that regard, provided that such becoming generally known cannot be blamed on an act or omission of the relevant party.

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**Article 8: Term**

This MOU has been entered into for an indefinite period. Each party is entitled to terminate this MOU subject to a notice period of 14 days. Notice of termination must be given in writing.

**Article 9: Choice of forum and choice of law**

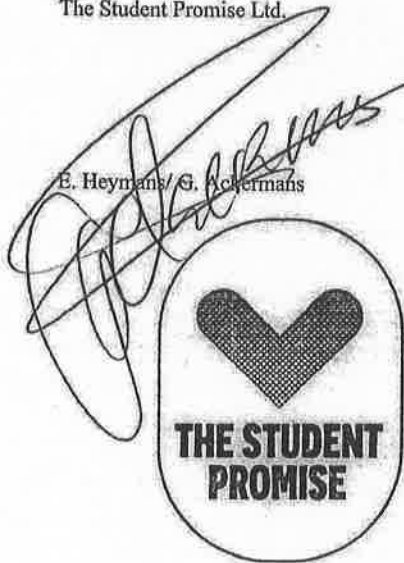
