On request of TCS, Associate shall execute from time to time, during or after the termination of his or her employment, such further instruments, including without limitations, applications for letters of patent, trademarks, trade names and copyrights or assignments thereof, as may be deemed necessary or desirable by TCS to perfect the title of TCS in the intellectual property rights and to effectuate the provisions hereof.
