7.2.1 Describe at least two institutional best practices successfully implemented

Practice-1:

1. Title of the Practice: Starting of the Institution Innovation Council (IIC) in the year 2020-21.

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- To provide Entrepreneurship opportunities to the students who are having entrepreneurial aptitude.

3. The Context:

- Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) of the institute was established in January 2016. In view of worldwide shortage of jobs leading to unemployment problems and lack of proper utilization of human resources, the EDC strives to identify talented youth having entrepreneurial aptitude.
- As per the AICTE norms, the scope of the EDC is widened to establish the Institution's Innovation Council, popularly known as IIC, under the banner of MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC), Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India. It promotes innovation and entrepreneurship in the institution through multitudinous modes leading to an innovation promotion ecosystem in the campus.

4. The Practice:

Major focus of IIC is in the following areas,

- To create a vibrant local innovation ecosystem.
- Start-up supporting mechanism in the institute.
- Prepare institute for Atal Ranking of institutions on innovation achievements framework.
- Establish function ecosystem for scouting ideas and pre-incubation of ideas.
- Develop better cognitive ability among students.

5. Evidence of Success:

In order to achieve the above objectives, IIC has conducted the following activities,

- Conducted various Innovation, IPR and entrepreneurship related activities prescribed by MIC in time bound fashion.
- Identify and reward innovations and share success stories.
- Organize periodic workshops / seminars / interactions with entrepreneurs, investors, professionals and create a mentor pool for student innovators.
- Network with peers and national entrepreneurship development organizations.
- Create an Institution's Innovation portal to highlight innovative projects carried out by institution's faculty and students.
- Organize Hackathons, idea competition, mini-challenges etc. with the involvement of industries.

Practice-2:

1. **Title of the Practice:** Awarding meritorious students with cash awards, tuition fee waiver and institution level scholarships.
2. **Objectives of the Practice:**
 - Few students come from poor financial background and their parents find it difficult to pay the tuition fees as well as hostel fees.
 - The objective of this practice is that these financially weak students should not be deprived of education.
3. **The Context:**
 - Students get motivated when they are awarded
 - Few private entrepreneurs / philanthropes who have constituted awards for students and they have expressed that institute should give away those awards in their names.
 - Financial weak students can complete their education. These are institution level scholarships and they are over and above the scholarships provided by Govt.
4. **The Practice:**
 - Every year the awards are given away to meritorious students during annual function. Class toppers of all three branches as well as university toppers get the cash awards from the institute.
 - Students are scrutinized by an independent financial support committee for tuition fee waiver and scholarship schemes.
5. **Evidence of success:**
 - Students get motivated for studies and they compete for the awards. Due to this, we have more and more university rankers as well.

Academic, Innovative and Entrepreneurial Financial Schemes

The Hope Foundation's International Institute of Information Technology (I²IT) offers several financial assistance schemes by way of scholarships, fee concession schemes, teaching and research assistance, financial assistance for entrepreneurial development etc. to meritorious and deserving students. Nurturing excellence is the underlying philosophy of I²IT. It is our endeavor to ensure that constraints like financial background don't deny a student his / her right to excel and find his / her place under the sun. Towards this end, a shortlist of deserving students is prepared and submitted to the **Student Financial Support Committee** of the Institute. They carefully scrutinize every case and recommend financial assistance, entry level and merit scholarships, academic excellence awards, and fee concessions to the eligible students. The quantum and number of categories and schemes for extending financial help are provided on a yearly basis and are subject to change from time to time.

Tuition Fee Concessions:

This benefit is extended to the Son / Daughter of Finolex Group Company Employee/s, Son / Daughter of the employee/s of Finolex Group Company promoted Educational Institutions (FAMT / I²IT), Son / Daughter of the employee/s of Katara Dental Private Limited and Physically challenged / Differently abled students. The fee concession in each of the mentioned cases above is provided @ 25% of the Tuition Fee (as approved by FRA or the Tuition Fee applicable in the case of students eligible for Government Scholarships) from the year of admission up to completion of graduation with the Institute.


Financial Assistance, Tuition Fee concession and Merit cum Means Scholarships will be extended for the ward/s of the employees in service with any of the Finolex Group of Companies, Finolex Group promoted Educational Divisions and Katara Dental Private Limited only if the parental annual income does not exceed Rs.10 Lacs (subject to submission of valid documentary evidences – Form 16 or IT returns of previous 3 years). In case the Tuition Fee concession, Merit cum Means scholarship needs to be finalized on similar parental annual income, preference would be given to the students from rural areas”. **Please refer Appendix – I for more information.**


Student Education Loan Assistance


The students enrolled with I²IT can avail financial assistance from various nationalized and private banks by way of Educational Loans. I²IT provides the necessary documentation to speed the education loan disbursement process, provided that the Admission process is completed in all respects.

Selection Procedure

Application in the prescribed form for the award of financial aid from the Institute in the relevant category for the previous Academic Year will have to be submitted to the Institute authorities on or before 31st October every year. Processing will be done by the Administrative Office and the selection of awardees will be done by the **Student Financial Support Committee (SFSC)**. The SFSC would announce the submission of application forms. Incomplete applications not having required certificates and other mandatory enclosures are liable to be rejected. The decision of the **Student Financial Support Committee** would be communicated to the selected students.

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
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
Note: All recognitions and achievements of the students at National and International level would be reviewed on a case-to-case basis and may be financially rewarded suitably. The decision of the management will be final and binding on all stakeholders.

Essential Eligibility Criteria


- a) Confirmed admission with the Institute is the primary criteria to be eligible for applying for financial aid for the First Year / Direct Second Year (as applicable). Eligibility for availing financial aid from the Institution for the previous academic year will be applicable ONLY if he / she continue to be a Bonafide student of the institution for the current academic year.
- b) The student applicant would have to apply in the prescribed Application Form for financial aid only. Along with the Application Form, duly attested copies of Attendance Report, Semester Mark sheets, Self Affidavit, No dues certificate from the Accounts Department, Caste Validity Certificate (if applicable), Conduct Certificate have to be submitted duly certified by the Academic and Administrative Heads of Departments. Documents for income proof (Form 16, 3 years IT returns) as applicable. In case the student avails Education Loan from banks for the purpose of payment of fee and charges and becomes eligible for fee concession and / or scholarships, they would be required to submit an NOC from the bank to receive the relevant Financial Aid from the Institute.
- c) All applicable fees and charges have to be cleared by the student applicant in all respects to the Institute to be eligible for applying for the financial assistance under the relevant category.
- d) It is mandatory for the applicant to ensure compliance of the minimum aggregate attendance requirement as prescribed by the affiliating university in each semester at the end of the relevant academic year.
- e) The student applicant must obtain 60% and above (improvement year on year is compulsory) in the annual examination conducted by the Savitribai Phule Pune University for the relevant academic year. Degradation in the academic performance below the stipulated percentage of 60% will not permit the student applicant to apply for financial aid of any manner including scholarships, and fee concessions across all categories for the relevant academic year.
- f) Student applicant with backlog subject/s during any particular academic year will NOT be eligible to apply for financial aid.
- g) Financial aid will be disbursed by the Institute by way of cheque payable at par in favor of the selected student applicant only.
- h) In case of a tie between student applicants for a particular category of financial aid, the total allocated award amount would be equally shared among the eligible student applicants in all applicable cases of financial assistance.



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

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- i) Student applicants in the reserved category who receive the entire 100% financial aid and benefits by way of Tuition fee from the Government of Maharashtra will not be eligible to apply for any Tuition Fee Concession benefits from the Institute. However, if the Social Welfare Office rejects his / her scholarship application, purely on the grounds of prescribed income limits from time to time, then such student would automatically be eligible to apply prospectively for financial aid with the Institute.
- j) Student applicants in the reserved category who receive partial financial aid and benefits by way of Tuition fee from the Government of Maharashtra will be eligible to apply for any Tuition Fee Concession benefits and would receive **"25% of the applicable Tuition Fee (subject to adjustment of Government Scholarship amount received, if any)"** from the Institute. However, if the Social Welfare Office rejects his / her scholarship application, purely on the grounds of prescribed income limits from time to time, then such student would automatically be eligible to apply prospectively for financial aid with the Institute.
- k) The student applicant has to understand that the benefit of the financial aid under the applicable category of the Institute will be applicable to him / her ONLY if he / she is NOT subjected to any disciplinary action by the Institute for any misconduct, misbehavior and violation of the rules and regulations.
- l) Prior to the submission of the application for financial aid, student applicant must take the confirmation on the Application Form from the Head of the Department (regarding attendance fulfillment and year on year improvement), the Accounts Officer (regarding fee dues clearance and NOC's for Education loan beneficiaries) and the Registrar / Assistant Registrar- Student Section (NOC for any disciplinary action initiated on Academic and Administrative grounds). Failure to do so, the Application Form for financial aid will not be accepted in any case.
- m) The last date for submitting the completely filled Application Form for financial aid (with all necessary documents) along with the endorsement requirements specified in point (k) above is 31st October. No Application Form / supporting document/s will be accepted after the prescribed due date in any case. Incomplete Application Form will be rejected and will not be processed. Delays (if any) beyond the control of the institute authorities in announcing the submission dates will be accommodated and shared with all applicants appropriately.
- n) The Application Form for financial aid submitted by the student applicant is only a request form. By filling and submitting the same to the Institute does not mean that the request has been granted. Awarding financial aid is purely under the prerogative of the competent authorities of the Institute.
- o) All Financial aid schemes listed in Appendix – I do not necessarily be awarded in the relevant academic year and will be finalized for selection at the sole discretion of the **Student Financial Support Committee** of the Institute.
