The overall purpose of the PMIS software is to strengthen the information management capability of ADPC to analyze data and allow managers to forecast informed decisions. Specific to the CARE for the South Asia Project, the PMIS has facilitated the implementation of project and performance tracking. ADPC is able to offer its stakeholders an agile and robust solution that substantially improves the administration and functionality of project management, aiding ADPC personnel in the performance of their duties.

The PMIS system has the following "core" modules:

- 1. Project Information
- 2. Activity Based Work Planning
- 3. Monitoring & Evaluation
- 4. Budgeting

Additionally, it has the following "supporting" modules:

- 1. Stakeholder Management
- 2. Procurement Management
- 3. Human Resource Management
- 4. Grievance Redressal System
- 5. Knowledge & Repository

The system is built using the Frappe Framework (https://frappeframework.com), which is a full-stack web framework written in Python, JavaScript and uses MariaDB for the database. The PMIS software's primary function is to facilitate and manage the required day-to-day project activities and monitoring by the project authorities. This is accomplished via secure communication capabilities to accept the required data, along with a secure Web Portal to allow the reporting, processing, and correction of various data submission errors. The Web Portal also allows designated project users to interact with the PMIS software and report to various authorities. We have successfully completed the development and system has been deployed at ADPC servers and currently we are working on add-on features under Annual Maintenance Contract.
