
20th January:

Activity Description in Nutshell: Treasure Rush was a Technical-Physical-Mental Hunt for the Treasure Hidden in the College Campus Area. It was conducted on the span of 2 days inclusive of 2 rounds. Round 1 was scheduled on the first day and Round 2 on the following day.

Round 1, titled '*Rush Me There*', served as an elimination and selection phase for the top 16 participants. In this round, participants teamed up in pairs. Each team was handed a sheet

containing the names of 23 places or objects encoded in a special format to add a layer of challenge. The encoding was designed to be not easily deciphered.

The task for each team was to physically visit the specified location or find the designated object, capture a photograph with it, and then submit the collected images within a 90-minute timeframe. The submissions were handed over to the coordinator.

Based on the scores, the top 8 teams were selected to advance to Round 2

Round 2 had the Technical aspect of the game and this was the final round to win the Treasure. In this round the 16 qualified participants were, divided into 4 teams each consisting of 4 members. The selection of the winner was divided into two levels.

1st Level: This level is where the teams had to perform solo. That means there were 4 tasks that had to be completed by each team and the top 3 teams that complete the tasks the earliest moves to the 2nd level. The 4 tasks were:

- Code: Debug and complete the given code, compile and run it.
- Cryptography: Decipher the text or numbers into an answer.
- Find It: Complete the given task to find and bring the object.
- Physical: Perform 3 physical tasks.

2nd Level: The 3 teams completing the previous round had given a password to a protected PDF file. This PDF file consisted of a hidden clue to a location in the campus. This location had a QR code stuck to it, which had the co-ordinates to the Final Location. The team to reach that locations wins the treasure.

Round 2 marked the technical climax of the game and served as the final challenge to claim the treasure. The 16 qualified participants were grouped into 4 teams, each comprising 4 members. The selection of the ultimate winner was structured into two levels.

1st Level: Each team had to undertake solo tasks. There were 4 tasks in total, and the top 3 teams completing these tasks in the shortest time advanced to the next level. The 4 tasks were:


- Code: Debug and complete the given code, compile and run it.

- Find It: Complete the given task to find and bring the object.
- Physical: Perform 3 physical tasks.





2nd Level: The three teams that successfully completed the first level were provided with a password to access a protected PDF file. Within this file lay a concealed clue pointing to a location somewhere on the campus. At this hidden spot, a QR code was affixed, containing the coordinates to the Final Location. The team that reached this final destination first emerged as the triumphant treasure winner.





- **Communication:** Participants need to be prepared to actively participate in the auction and communicate bids clearly. Respectful interaction with fellow teams is essential.

Rules of the College IPL Auction:

- **Player Categories:** Players will be categorized as [Batsmen, Bowlers, All-Rounders] with varying point values reflecting their skills and current form.
- **Bidding Caps:** To ensure all teams have a fair chance, individual spending caps and/or total auction spending limits may be implemented.
- **Tiebreakers:** In case of tie bids, a predetermined tiebreaker round will





be held to determine the winning team.

- **Fair Play:** Upholding sportsmanship and ethical conduct is paramount throughout the event. Any violation of rules or disrespectful behavior may lead to penalties or disqualification.
