Activity Description:

The ACM Student Chapter of the International Institute of Information Technology, Pune, organized ByteBattles 2025, a college-wide coding contest. The event took place on September 9, 2025, from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM in Computer Centre, 213, 214, 223 & 225.

The contest was hosted on the GDG platform and featured a diverse set of questions designed to test students' skills across different domains. The question paper was tailored to various academic years, ensuring a fair challenge for all participants.

- For Third and Final Year (TE and BE) Students: The paper consisted of a total of 20 questions. This included 2 core coding questions that required participants to write and submit code. The remaining questions were in Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) format, comprising 8 Data Structures and Algorithms (DSA) questions, 5 Data Analytics questions, and 5 Aptitude questions.
- For Second Year (SE) Students: The paper was structured differently, with a total of 20 questions. This section included 2 core coding questions and a set of 13 DSA MCQ questions, along with 5 Aptitude questions.
- The contest provided a valuable platform for students to demonstrate their problem-solving and technical abilities in a competitive environment. The event saw enthusiastic participation, with students from all years engaging in the challenge.

ByteBattles 2025 was a resounding success, effectively achieving its goal of fostering a competitive coding culture among students at the International Institute of Information Technology, Pune. 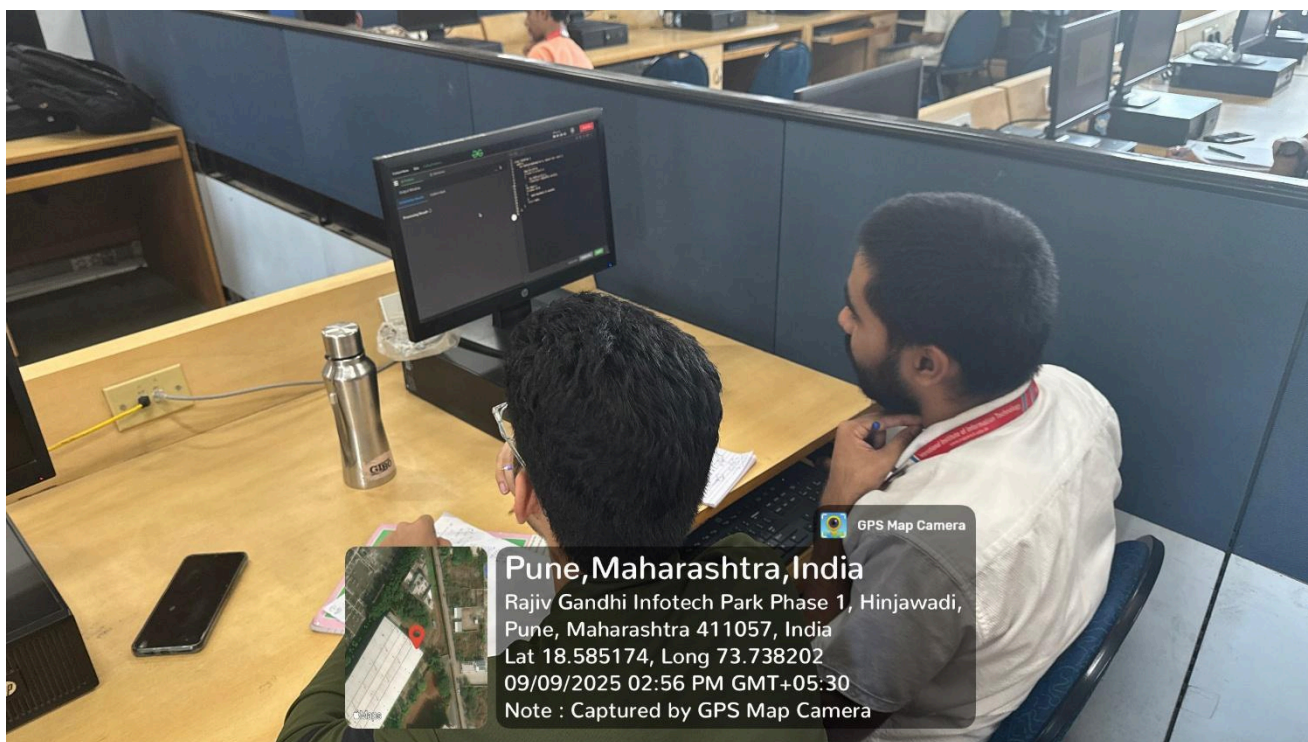
