He lived briefly in Amritsar and moved to Coona in 1945. Working his way through stints as a domestic servant, a collection agent, a trader and a sales agent, he eventually became a supplier of defence equipment to the Indian Army.

He was elected to the Rajya Sabha in 1958 along with other members of the party.
