For the Audit Course, students explored relevant and contemporary subjects. The topic for Third Year (TE) students was "**Green and Unconventional Energy**", focusing on sustainable energy solutions and innovative technologies. Final Year (BE) students studied "**Cyber Laws and Use of Social Media**", which covered legal aspects of the digital world and responsible online behavior. These topics aimed to broaden students' awareness and understanding of critical issues beyond their core curriculum.
