Activity Description in Nutshell:

During the second semester of the academic year 2023-24, BE students were offered the Audit course titled "Cyber Laws and Use of Social Media". The syllabus comprised units such as Introduction to IT Act, Cyber Law from an International Perspective, Cyber Forensic and Computer Crimes, and the Use of Social Media. To enhance understanding and engagement with the course material, a video-making activity took place on April 5th, 2024.

Students collaborated in groups of four, with a total of 19 teams participating. Prior to presenting their videos, students provided briefings on their chosen topics. The event commenced with an inauguration by Dr. Risil Chatrala and was judged by Dr. Varsha Degaonkar.

Following thorough evaluation based on predefined criteria, three winning teams were recognized. The third position was secured by Team BI-04, the second position by Team BI-05, and the first position by Team BI-19. Winners were awarded with prizes as a token of appreciation. This activity was conducted under the mentorship of Dr. Bhavana Kanawade.

Event Objectives (EO):

1. Understand the fundamental principles and regulations governing cyber laws and social media usage.
2. Analyze the legal implications and consequences of cyber activities, including cybercrimes and privacy violations.
3. Evaluate the ethical considerations and societal impacts associated with the use of social media platforms.
4. Develop effective communication skills through video production while addressing legal and social aspects of cyberspace.
